Conservation and Presentation of Mosaics: At What Cost? First Circular

The 12th Conference of the International Committee for the Conservation of Mosaics (ICCM) will be held in Sardinia (Italy), **October 27-31, 2014**, at the invitation of the Soprintendenza per i Beni Archeologici per le province di Sassari e Nuoro (Ministero dei Beni, delle Attività Culturali e del Turismo); with support from the University of Sassari, The Getty Foundation and the University of Cyprus.

Conference theme and Call for Papers and Posters

The theme of the 12th Conference is:

Conservation and Presentation of Mosaics: At What Cost?

The cost of conservation and presentation of mosaics is usually defined in financial terms. This may entail preventive measures such as maintenance, or remedial ones such as stabilisation. In fact, the act of conservation and presentation exacts many different costs, which may be beneficial or detrimental to mosaic heritage:

- o Aesthetic costs through intervention: appearance and authenticity
- o Human costs of management, training and staffing
- o Socio-political costs, such as the impact of excavation, development and tourism

Conservation decisions are heavily influenced by the financial resources available, requiring some degree of compromise, which may affect the display of mosaics and their original context, as well as the implementation of preventive conservation measures. What types of approaches mitigate these compromises to reach ethical and sustainable solutions? What is the acceptable limit of such compromises?

There are no exemplary models for costing mosaic conservation, particularly for mosaics in situ on archaeological sites, where monetary costs are often unrecorded, making budgeting and planning very difficult. This hampers good site maintenance. The conference invites presentations of the financial planning and execution of conservation and maintenance of mosaics on sites, in storage and in museums. It also aims to explore how social and political decisions may have a positive or a negative impact on the conservation of mosaics.

In addition, papers are invited to address the following sub-themes:

- o Methods of survey and documentation
- o Conservation and management of mosaics
- o Presentation and display
- o Education and training
- o Best practice case studies

Language and Translation

The official languages to be used during the conference will be English, French and Italian. Papers and posters will be accepted only in these three languages for presentation and publication. Papers in other languages will not be accepted.

Simultaneous translation in these languages will be provided. Translation into Arabic will be considered if funds are available.

Venues

The opening ceremony will take place at the University of Sassari.

Formal sessions will be held at Alghero, as well as Sassari.

The organisers will provide transport between Alghero and Sassari for all participants.

Presentations

Presentations will be limited to 20 minutes, followed by 10 minutes discussion. There will also be short presentations lasting a total of 15 minutes, and a poster session. Guidelines will be sent in due course to the authors whose papers or posters have been accepted for presentation.

Conference visits and tours

There will be organised visits to Sassari, Alghero, Porto Torres, the nuraghe of Saint' Antine and Sant' Andrea Priu, Tharros and Bosa. In addition, an optional two/three day, post-conference tour in central and southern Sardinia will be organised at an extra cost. The exact price will be announced in the Second Circular.
